




GAME MANAGEMENT WE COMPLAIN ABOUT HOW LONG SOME GAMES TAKE

- Be on time (1/2 hour before game at game site)
 - Report in to home team
 - Be at plate 10 mins before game for conference
- Between innings
 - Hustle to position
 - Keep players moving
 - Count pitches 2 left tell hitter and pitcher
 - Don't meet with partner (unless needed)
 - Don't sit in dugouts, talk idly with coaches or fans
 - Make sure paperwork is done

UMPIRE'S RESPONSIBILITIES



- Game management
 - Pace of the game
 - Line-up Card
- Follow the Code of Ethics
- Get the calls right
- Know the rules
- Ignore the crowd
- Know the mechanics of the game
- Train to improve



UMPIRE / COACH INTERACTION



- Who can 'discuss' issues with the umpires?
- Which umpire should he go to?
- What kind of calls can be discussed?
- Warnings?
- Chirping from dugout



GIVING WARNINGS

- Don't say "one more word" or "not another word"
- Can use a look, "coach I hear you" or "that's enough" for a subtle reminder that you hear them.
- Say "coach, this is your warning" and write it down
- Write down all warnings, restrictions and ejections on the line-up card
- Need to report restrictions and ejections
- Ejection report should include all warnings issued.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE COACHES

- Body language
- Let coach speak first
- Don't let them repeat
- Tone of your voice?
- Volume of your voice?
- Actions

PARTNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- Keep it one-on-one
- Get within ear shot
- Step in after partner turns his back
- Escort coach after restriction or ejection
- Do not touch coach or players
